# MODEL SCALES

## N Scale vs. HO Scale vs. O Scale

### Proportion and Size

It's easy to define the various scales in terms of a ratio. N is 1:160 the size of real trains, HO is 1:87, and O scale is 1:48. This means, for example, that HO is 1/87th as long as its prototype, 1/87th as tall, and in every dimension its proportions are 1:87. In terms of actual size, HO scale locomotives and freight cars, depending on the type (whether it's a switcher engine or a more modern GE locomotive, for example) could range anywhere from 5" to 9" long and about 2" high. The track is 1 1/8" wide. N scale is just about half the size of HO, with locomotives and cars measuring about 3" to 4" long and 1" high, and the track 5/8" wide. O scale is the biggest of the three, with locomotives being anywhere from one to two feet long, and about 5"-6" high; the track is about 2-1/4" wide. If you are familiar with classic Lionel trains, then you know what size O is.

### Pricing

Contrary to what might seem logical, there is no ratio between price and size when it comes to scale models. HO and N scale tend to be in the same price range when it comes to locomotives; however HO freight cars are about twice as expensive as N scale. In contrast, O products are significantly more expensive than both HO and N due not only because of its size, but because of the smaller market, type of detail and auxiliary features (like sound) that are the cornerstone of O railroading.

### Operating Ability

Because of its minute size, N scale tends to be considered the "operating scale," enabling you to fit a complex layout with lots of operating capability into a small space. HO takes up a lot more

### Product Availability

Since HO is the most popular scale (by definition of the most modelers engaging in it), it's the scale that enjoys the greatest variety of available products. N scale is second to HO, and has picked up speed in the race for popularity over the past ten years. The variety of products available in N scale therefore follows close behind HO. O gauge, on the other hand, are offered by a select few companies, limiting the variety of products available. However, Atlas O, LLC has added significantly to the amount and type of products available for O modelers everywhere. To order an Atlas O catalog, please call (908) 687-9590.

space, but some consider it to be a more reasonable size to handle. HO tends to offer just as much operation ability as N, it just requires a larger area to do it in. O scale layouts tend to be less complex, but no less fun, since they generally incorporate sound, operating accessories and other such functions which make operation exciting and very life-like.

A heavy hauler from the mid-1960's, the SD-35 was used by many railroads in the US for service in the coal, petroleum and chemical producing industries. Built by the Electro-Motive Division of the General Motors Corporation in 1964-1965, the SD-35 had a "boxy" appearance resulting from its stretched GP-35 frame.

Having halted production of passenger cab units, EMD made some adjustments to the SD-35 model. The new SDP-35 was ready for service in 1965 with a steam generator suitable for passenger service yet easily converted to freight service.

Atlas' true-to-life SD-35 series locomotives are packed with incredible details including a realistic die-cast underframe, a five-pole skewed armature motor with dual-flywheels for optimum performance at all speeds, directional lighting, separately-installed scale windshield wipers, metal grab irons and fine scale handrails, as well as factory-installed AccuMate® couplers.

### What's the difference between Atlas HO Code 83 and Code 100 track?

Literally, the code of a piece of track is the height of the rail in thousandths of an inch (meaning code 83 rail is .083" high; code 100 rail is .100" high). The significant difference lies in the physical appearance of the two types of track. Atlas code 83 track has fine, brown ties whereas code 100 has slightly thicker black ties.

Because of its accuracy (and the color of the ties), code 83 is more prototypical, and therefore more realistic than code 100. Code 83 is known as a finer-scale track,

and is the choice of discerning modelers. Atlas carries a full line of both code 100 and code 83 products.

### I've heard some rolling stock may not run on Code 83 track. Is this true?

The only rolling stock that may have problems on any code 83 track are some older European-mode models. The reason is the flanges are too large. If you are running trains made within the last 20 years or so, you should not have a problem with Atlas code 83 track.

Yes, Atlas' brand of roadbed track is called True-Track®. Product listing on page 23, True-Track contains a section of code 83 track, snapped into a gray, graveled roadbed base. It is easy to assemble and can be set up just about anywhere because it does not need to be secured to a board.

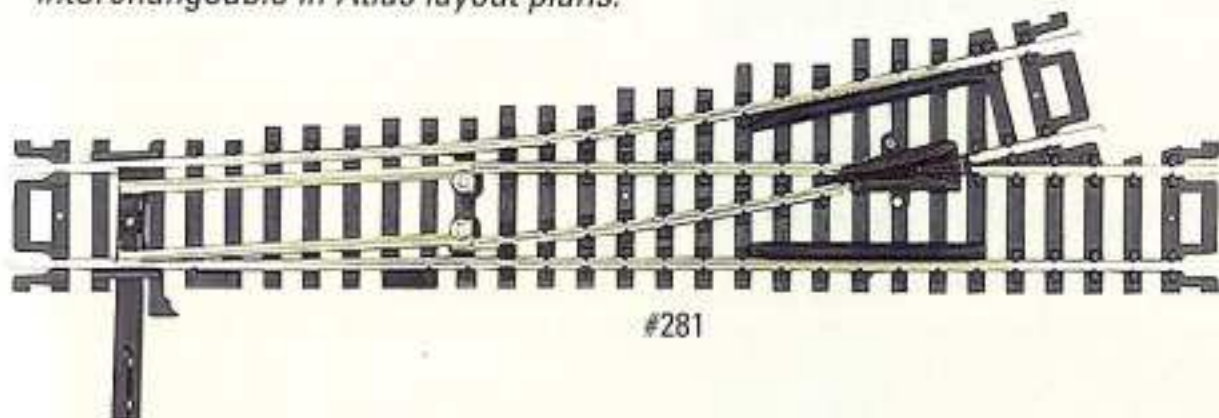
### What is the Difference Between a #4 and a #6 Custom-Line® Turnout?

The difference is the angle at which the two tracks diverge or split. With #4 turnouts, the tracks diverge at a sharper angle than the #6's. Therefore, the type of turnout you use may be determined by the space you have for your layout.

### What is the Difference Between Custom-Line® Turnouts and Snap Switches®?

1. Custom-Line® Turnouts are #4, #6 or Wye turnouts. The track section of the Atlas #4 turnout splits at an angle of 12 degrees and 50 minutes; for #6 switches that angle is 9 degrees, 30 minutes; and for Wye switches it is 19 degrees, 12 minutes. This angle determines how sharp of a turn the switch (and therefore your trains) will make. For Snap-Switches®, we describe the 18" radius that the switch is designed to create. If a Snap-Switch® and included 1/3 18" radius is connected to 11, 18" radius curved sections of track with a 1-1/2" piece opposite the switch, a complete oval will result.

2. Custom-line® Turnouts have metal frogs that can be powered if necessary. Snap-Switches® have plastic frogs which cannot be powered. NOTE: A Snap-Switch® and a #4 Custom-line Turnout are not interchangeable in Atlas layout plans.
