Based upon cars built by the General American Car Company for the Cudahy Packing Co. in 1925, the 36' wood reefer is representative of thousands of cars that transported meat, dairy, beer and food products well into the 1960s, acting as rolling, eye-catching advertisements. Sure to elicit delight from onlookers, they bring realistic fun to your layout!

Arriving just in time to make your holiday layout brighter, these exact replicas feature accurate painting and lettering, separately-applied grab irons, ladders and stirrups, two different road name specific hatch styles, truss rods appropriate per road name, separately-applied door hardware, opening hatches and doors, a die-cast chassis, detailed braking system and 40-ton Bettendorf-style trucks.

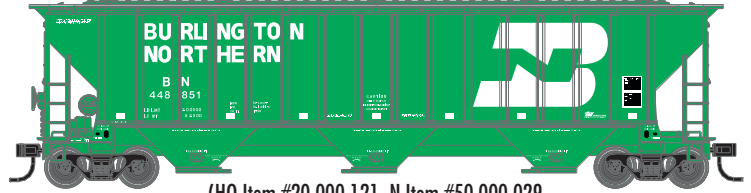

HO ACF® 89' 4" Flat Cars

Modern layouts will achieve heightened realism with the addition of the ACF® 89' 4" flat car, introduced in the late 60s as a result of a continuing need for more intermodal platform capacity. The all-new Atlas model is based on the 1973 version, originally designed to carry two trailers or combinations with containers. The cars continue in use by TTX Company and various railroads in intermodal service. Many were modified in the late 80s to accept longer trailers. Most

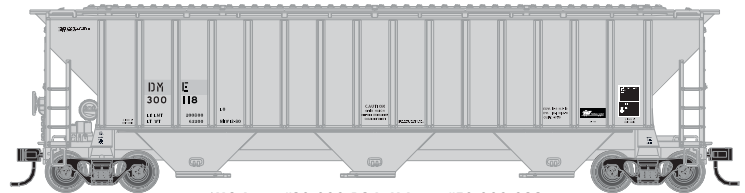
remaining in TTX service today have been modified with three hitches to accommodate up to three shorter package trailers. Our finely detailed new model offers three different styles of hitch.

Scheduled for December delivery, the 89' 4" Flat Car is based on ACF® plans and features container pedestals, correct model year jack pads and AccuMate® couplers. They are available in five road names, each with four road numbers. The two undecorated units offer different body styles.

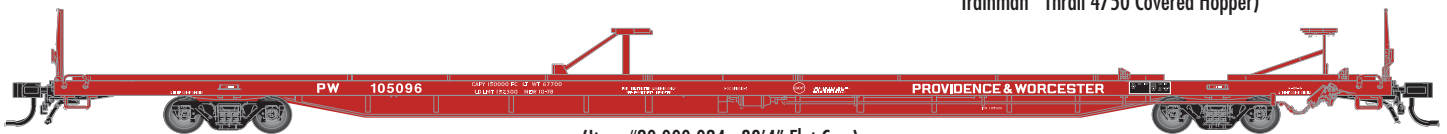
Atlas Trainman® Thrall 4750 Covered Hopper - in HO & N Scales!

This covered hopper model is based on a late 1970s 263,000 lbs GRL (Gross Rail Loading) 4750 cubic-foot capacity designed by Thrall Car primarily for grain transport.

Announced in July 2007, both scales are estimated for delivery in December 2007, making them ideal choices for holiday giving. Both the HO and N Scale versions feature a weighted body, have accurate painting and lettering, and are equipped with AccuMate® Knuckle Couplers. The HO Scale version is additionally outfitted with trucks equipped with free-rolling metal wheels.
