
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

The Atlas Classic N Scale SD-7 Locomotive is based on the prototype manufactured by EMD from February 1952 to November 1953. Utilizing a 1,500 hp engine and a longer underframe than the GP-7, the SD-7 was the first locomotive to use EMD's Flexicoil truck.

N SCALE

Built by EMD between 1954 and 1959, the SD-9 6-axle road switchers produced 1,750 HP and were used primarily for freight service throughout the US, both on main and secondary lines. Many SD-9 locomotives are still in service today, serving as road switchers for shortline & industrial railroads, and as yard switchers for major "Class 1" lines.


Primarily used for heavy-haul road freight service throughout the US, the C-628 generated a total of 2,750 hp, and was part of the American Locomotive Company's (ALCO) Century Locomotive Line. A total of 185 units were built by ALCO for railroads in the US, Mexico and Australia between 1963 and 1968.

N SCALE

During 1965 Alco started producing the 3,000 hp. Century 630 Locomotive. It was produced concurrently with the 2,800 hp. C-628, but it incorporated an advanced GE a.c. traction alternator which provided the extra 200 hp. The most distinctive spotting feature of the C-630 is the large aftercooler radiator housing which extends above the roofline (the aftercooler radiators enhanced the performance of the locomotive while operating under a heavy load). The C-630 also featured a modified cab which offered more interior space for the crew. Through the end of production in the late 1960s, a total of 133 units were produced for railroads in the US and Canada.

By late 1948, close to 14,000 of the original 24,500 USRA double-sheathed cars had been rebuilt with quite a degree of variation including the end, door and underframe. These steel side rebuilds were far more popular than their single-sheathed counterparts and make a great addition to the Atlas N scale product line.



An increased use of shipping containers during the 1970s led to new designs of railway cars for carrying them. The standard cars used at the time were full plate-deck 85' and 89' flat cars with 70-ton trucks. However, each 20-foot international shipping container of the era could gross some 25 tons – thus a flat car carrying four at maximum gross would be 100 tons. In an effort to address this weight issue, new flat cars with open decks and 100 ton trucks were placed in service and eventually used for a new railroad commodity – trash containers.

Atlas' model follows the open-deck flat design commonly seen in trash trains around the United States. The model also follows the prototypes used in international container service.

The more commonly seen ISO 20' intermodal containers are used for transporting new-products from country-to-country. The 20' MSW intermodal container differs greatly from its ISO 20' relative by being much taller and having a top lid. The 20' MSW containers are 12 foot tall (compared to 8.5' tall on the ISO 20's).

20' MSW containers usually travel in large blocks or solid trains on 80- and 89-foot flat cars. The MSW container design is based on a steel frame incorporating ISO components for interchangeability. Each container is equipped with fork lift pockets for loading, unloading and moving around transfer facilities. Each container is also equipped a fire port on one side.

During this same time-period, ALCO offered a six-axle road-switcher which was more commonly found in the west. The RSD-4/5 was externally very similar to the RS-3, having six-axle trucks as an obvious spotting feature. They produced the same 1,600hp as an RS-3, but offered increased tractive effort due to the use of a larger generator. Many RSD-4/5s were assigned to operate in mountainous territory (with varying degrees of success) on the Southern Pacific, Santa Fe and the Utah Railway.

Introduced in 1949, the Electro-Motive 1500hp GP-7 combined the machinery of the F7 with a hood-type carbody that offered high visibility and easy engine access. The GP-7 was used in pulling every conceivable type of train and was sometimes substituted for part of a set of cab units. The Atlas N Scale GP-9 "torpedo boat" model (aka "torpedo tube") is a 1750hp locomotive that was originally equipped for passenger service. The large portioned underbelly fuel and water tank required the distinctive torpedo shaped air reservoirs to be mounted on top of the long hood.

Built between 1976 and 1982, the EMD GP15-1 4-axle diesel locomotive was powered by a 12-cylinder EMD 645E engine that generated 1,500hp. It was commonly used as a light road switcher or a yard switcher.

In the early 70s, America's railroads were looking for a cost effective way to manage their aging secondary unit fleet. In 1975, EMD's jump to the rebuild market resulted in the GP15-1 locomotive. Rated at 1,500 horse power, the GP15-1 was marketed as a "remanufactured" unit which was only available via trade in. The locomotive was produced using the trucks, traction motors and main generators from the respective railroad's trade in unit. Other features of the GP15-1 include 12-cylinder 645E prime mover, single 48" radiator fan enclosed in a "tunnel motor" like housing and a standard 2,400 gallon fuel tank. A total of 310 units were built for American railroads.
