

#### **100 YEARS OF ATLAS HISTORY**

Atlas Tool Company was founded by Stephan Schaffan Sr. in 1924 as a general machine shop in a small garage at 330 Waverly Avenue in Newark, New Jersey. His son, Stephan Schaffan Jr. joined him in the business in 1933. As a frequent visitor to the local hobby shop, he would often ask the owner if there was anything he could do to earn some extra spending money. Tired of listening to his requests, the hobby-store owner threw some model railroad track parts his way and said, "Here, see if you can improve on this".

In those days, railroad modelers had to assemble and build everything from scratch. Steve Jr. created a "switch kit" which sold so well, that the entire family worked on them in the basement at night, while doing business as usual in the machine shop during the day.

Not long after, Steve Jr.'s accomplishments include engineering the stapling of rail to fiber track, inventing the first practical rail joiner and pre-assembled turnouts and flexible track—all of which helped to popularize model railroading and assisted in the creation of a mass-market hobby. As the business grew, their manufacturing needs went beyond what the small garage could provide, so in 1947 Steve and his father had the first factory built in Hillside, New Jersey at 413 Florence Avenue. On September 30th, 1949, Atlas Tool Company Inc. was officially incorporated as a New Jersey company.

Over time Atlas, has expanded their product line to include much more than just track. At your local hobby store you can pick up Atlas track, locomotives, freight cars, signals, lighting and more in HO, N, O and even Z scale.

To mark the 100th anniversary of Atlas, we are publishing special edition Anniversary Catalogs throughout 2024. This catalog, featuring HO & N scale products is Volume 3 of our Anniversary Collection.





The GP39-2 was offered by EMD as a fuel-efficient alternative to their very popular GP38-2 model. This efficiency resulted from the use of a turbocharged 12-cylinder 645E3 diesel engine, as opposed to the non-turbocharged 16-cylinder prime mover in the GP38-2. The use of a turbocharger increased the horsepower output from 2,000 to 2,300hp with four fewer cylinders. One other benefit of the turbocharger is improved operation at higher altitudes where thin air causes normally-aspirated diesels to lose power and produce excess smoke. The largest original fleet of GP39-2s was assembled by the Santa Fe who, over the course of seven years, acquired a total of 106 units.





In 1939, the Baldwin Locomotive Works introduced a standard line of production switchers featuring a cast frame, an end cab and low hood for improved visibility for the crew, and the option of either a 6- or 8-cylinder in-line diesel, which would deliver 660 or 1000 horsepower. These prime movers were based on a De La Vergne design, with vertical cylinders, low fuel pressure requirements, and spherical combustion chambers, a design which provided a broader power curve and could tolerate lower grade fuel than high-pressure fuel injector systems. The "V0-1000" generated 60,000 pounds of starting tractive effort, and 34,000 pounds continuous — values which were extremely useful for branchlines, yard work, and industrial switching such as in steel mills.

As early as February of 1940, Baldwin announced they would be manufacturing the 660 and 1000 horsepower switchers "for stock", as compared to producing to order. Even during wartime, this was a risky proposition, however such confidence paid off, as by the time production ended in 1946, Baldwin had produced nearly 550 1000 horsepower units, making the "VO-1000" one of the most popular naturally aspirated diesel switchers built — and rebuilt — over their long operational lifetimes.

The General Electric U28C locomotive, developed in 1966, provided a 300 horsepower increase over its predecessor, the U25C. Built on a larger frame than the U25C, the model also incorporated other improvements, such as new floating bolster trucks. A passenger-hauling variant, the U28CG, was produced for the Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway. These units were painted in the timeless red and silver Warbonnet paint scheme and put into service on the Texas Chief, replacing well aged F units. 



In the mid-1970s Amtrak was looking for a suitable replacement for the famed GG1 electric locomotives which had been in service since the mid-1930s. The approved design for what became the AEM-7 was from a Swedish company, ASEA, and was built starting in 1978 by EMD, utilizing original bodies by Budd, with the remaining components imported from Sweden. Amtrak's original order for 47 units was delivered between 1980 and 1982, with an additional seven in 1988. By the early 90's, a variant of this locomotive, the ALP-44, was produced for New Jersey Transit. All units have since been retired, but, like their GG1 predecessor, examples of both the AEM-7 and ALP-44 have been saved through donations to rail museums.

Over their years of service, Amtrak applied numerous paint schemes, and both Amtrak and NJT added ditchlights to their units, which are featured in this release. The alternate history PRR "heritage scheme" is an adaptation of the original pre-Lowey GG1 design from 1934, and is included as an homage to the history of electric locomotive power.

In 1947, REA ordered 500 of these all new steel express reefers from ACF, in an effort to handle express and parcel traffic. During the same time period, Atlantic Coast Line purchased 50. 
The FMC 5347 boxcar was manufactured by the FMC Corporation, a company known for producing a variety of freight railcars, in the 1970s and 1980s. The "5347" in the name refers to the car's capacity in cubic feet, making it a larger boxcar compared to earlier FMC models such as the 5077 (also available from Atlas). These cars were very prominent during the "IPD" (incentive per diem) era. Many featured colorful paint schemes and logos, a welcome change from earlier eras when most boxcars were much plainer.

FMC was acquired by Greenbrier in 1985. Production at the Oregon plant continued under the name Gunderson.

Pulpwood is not a specific type of wood, but actually tree limbs that are cut to a specified length, then turned into wood pulp and used in the paper industry. Early paper making had the trees near the paper plant. As timber resources were diminished, the need for transporting pulpwood began to rise. Railroads were seen as an efficient method of transporting pulpwood. Pulpwood in the Southeast and Northeast is generally cut into four-foot or less lengths and loaded onto "V-deck" bulkhead flat cars. The Ford Taurus of 1996 was the third generation of what had become the best-selling car in America between 1992-1995. From its' initial release in 1986, the Taurus had been one of the most anticipated cars for Ford, as it was the first designed and manufactured according to statistical quality control processes and introduced effective aerodynamic styling that rapidly became a standard in the industry. While the performance and handling was better than previous generations, the radical redesign (and higher cost) was more than the public could appreciate, and over 50% of sales in 1996 were to fleet owners. By 1997, The Taurus had lost the title of the best-selling car in America to the more conservatively styled Toyota Camry.
