2011 presents a step change in production for Dapol over previous years, with many new heralded and non heralded models being produced in both 'N' and 'OO' gauges.



Class 26 Diesel Locomotive




The BR Class 26 is one of the last 'missing links' in transition era Diesel Locomotives.




