Graham Farish Buildings

Every layout needs buildings but, apart from kits, nobody makes them as complete finished models for the British 'N' Gauge Market.

Well, now Graham Farish do! Not everybody has the patience, or skill to make up kits properly, and even fewer can really say that their paintwork on the finished model satisfies them. But ours will! So why not let

the experts do it? Give your layout a touch of class with a Graham Farish building.

And here they are: A superbly detailed signal box painted and finished correctly. A delightful Station halt which comes complete with realistic painted platform and ramps. The ramps are also available separately, as are the platform straights, which incorporate locking slots to create terminus stations.



9001. Platform Straights 4" long \times 1 3 /16" wide. 9002. Platform Ramps 2 1 /2" long tapers to 1 /2" wide. 9003. Station Halt complete overall length 9". 9004. Signal Box overall base 2 1 /8" long \times 1 1 /16" wide.


Special slots along the platform sides enable multi-platform termini to be built. Graham Farish platforms also have invisible push-out, square locating holes for other fittings if wanted.

This little group of buildings is only the start of this range, and more will be released from time to time.









1409. Hall 4-6-0 Motorised Chassis.







1509. Merchant Navy 4-6-2 Motorised Chassis.

You get much more realistic trackwork this way because you avoid those rigid curves and there are fewer joints between the sections.



The very popular Graham Farish Super Liveway Pointwork has undergone some technical improvements to its design and


is now even better than before!

Not only is it self-isolating (which means that power is supplied to the track only in the direction to which the point is set) but it also has a Live Metal Frog to give you that better slow running control without hesitation through the Point itself, which has always been the drawback of the dead frog system.

The ingenious new feature is that the switching blades are now pivoted and are also diecast so that the curve of the blades is always precisely correct and does not require adjustment.

0069. Remote Control Point Lever Mechanism.

This is a brand new Accessory developed by us for use with our own points, and which is designed to work with the excellent Ratio remote control system with Lever Frame which is included in this Accessory pack. An extremely useful development which will find its way onto many layouts.
